SUMMER SYMPHONY A SUCCESS!

The summer session of the Icicle Creek Youth Symphony, the Icicle Creek Summer Symphony Day Camp is a fun, week-long orchestral experience held at the Center's campus. This year, nearly 70 young musicians from all over the state participated. The 2005 Summer Symphony program, which ran from June 27 to July 2, included two divisions: the Symphony Orchestra, conducted by Icicle Creek's Resident Conductor, Jonathan Pasternack, and the Academy Orchestra, led by Kara Hunnicutt, one of the region's most experienced and capable string teachers. Other faculty for the Summer Symphony Day Camp included a number of seasoned professionals from the North Central Washington area as well as music teachers and performing artists from Seattle, Pullman, Bellingham and New York City.

Highlights of the week featured presentations to the entire student body of a jazz improvisation demonstration, a faculty chamber orchestra mini-recital and a concert by Seattle's Bottom Line Duo (bass and cello). A final concert on July 2 at Wenatchee's Performing Arts Center capped the week's events. The Symphony and Academy Orchestras shared the stage with an African marimba ensemble under the direction of Sherry Krebs.

Her terrific wit, deep musical knowledge and sometimes wacky sense of entertainment have made Lisa the perfect announcer for KOHO-FM Radio's "Sunday Morning Classics," a position she has held for two years and will continue in as Executive Director of Icicle Creek.

Like many people who are drawn to our area, Lisa and her husband, David Fluharty, a marine scientist and University of Washington professor, both love outdoor recreation, hiking, skiing, and fly-fishing.

We are thrilled that Lisa is at the helm of the Icicle Creek Music Center and look forward to a wonderful future of music making!

CENTER'S FACILITIES AMONG ITS MANY OFFERINGS

The beautiful facilities of the Icicle Creek Music Center's Leavenworth campus are an important part of the Center's many offerings. The grounds include the Canyon Wren Recital Hall, equipped with a recording booth and rehearsal room with piano, two ensemble rehearsal buildings, each with a piano, three small practice huts, and an office building with a teaching studio and conference room. There are also eight air-conditioned lodging units, including two kitchenettes. Since the opening of the campus two years ago, the Center has made the facilities available for rental to individuals and organizations that can take full advantage of its unique features. Musical ensembles from Port Townsend High School, Lake Washington High School in Kirkland, Eckstein Middle School in Seattle, Wenatchee High School and Tyee Middle School in Bellevue have come for multi-day 'retreats.'

Canyon Wren is the weekly rehearsal site for the Marlin Handbell Ringers and has been the chosen venue for CD recordings by school choirs and local artists such as singer Matt Baldwin. In addition to being the location for Icicle Creek Music Center's own Chamber Music Institute and Summer Symphony Day Camp, the Center's campus has also provided homes for several regional and nationwide arts programs such as the Icicle Creek Young Actors Conservatory, the Sonatina workshop for Adult Amateur Pianists and the Cascade Early Music Festival.
